Once you've been praying for them, intentionally engage them in conversations. Ask open-ended questions. Hear their story. Be a loving, caring, listening friend. Reserve judgment. Invest in the relationship. Don't have an agenda except for God's agenda. Have patience. Follow the Spirit's promptings. Your presence is more important than your perfection. Keep on praying.

As the relationship grows and trust develops, share more of your story and the details of how God is impacting your life. Be authentic and transparent. Share the ups and downs. Be spiritually obvious without being religiously obnoxious.
